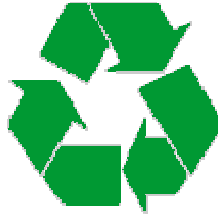

Did you know that 1 million printer cartridges are discarded into America's landfills every day and that each cartridge takes over 1,000 years to decompose? Worse yet are the 500 million used cell phones in the U.S. that are sitting on shelves or in our landfills. More than 2 million used phones are disposed of each week, adding tons of toxic waste into our landfills.

You can help keep Hawaii green and support the Hawaii Red Cross by setting up a recycling program in your office, organization, or school. It's cost-free and hassle-free because we supply everything you need.
